Somerset County Cricket Club - Pegasus Court

Pegasus Court is a new development of high end apartments directly overlooking one of the UK's most well known Cricket grounds.

This Sir Robert Macalpine development in Taunton offers a total of 65 apartments featuring 44 one-bedroomed apartments, 19 two-bedroomed apartments and 2 Penthouse apartments.

One of the main design features of Pegasus Court was to have a large roof terrace on the top floor overlooking the Cricket ground. An added feature of this was to have the terrace coloured in the colours of the Somerset Cricket team of cream and burgundy.

The roof garden, of around 240m², and surrounding balconies, of around 200m², are of concrete slab construction with screed to falls into stainless steel gutters.

With curtain walling and doorways overlooking the whole of the area, there was a large amount of detail work encompassed in the job.

To deal with this level of detail and to provide a hard wearing surface in the appropriate colours, the only solution was a liquid product, namely, Liquid plastics Balcons.

The Balcons walkway and balcony system comes with the following benefits:

The whole area of the roof garden and balconies had two coats of LPL bonding Primer applied and the edges of the gutters were coated with LPL Metal Primer. A coat of cement grey Balcons was applied with Reemat Premium embedded. This basecoat was dressed down into the gutters to provide a continuous seal.

The balcony areas were then given a topcoat of pebble grey and the roof garden was coated with a light ivory and a copper brown to match the requested colours.

To give a tough, skid resistant finish, quartz granules were broadcast into the topcoat and this was then overcoated with the appropriate colour Balcons to give a uniform finish.

The job had a two week timescale and was completed on time and within budget.

As can be seen from the photographs, the end result was absolutely stunning!
